* **TCHS Graduation Requirements and Course of Study**

- * Theology I, II, III, IV
- * English I, II, III, IV

- * World Geography, Civics, United States History, World History
- * Physical Science, Biology I, Chemistry, and Sr. Science Course
- * HPE I and PE II
- * Electives – 6 units (Check TOPS University Diploma)
- * Religious Studies I, II, III, IV

Louisiana TOPS University Diploma

- * Required for admission to four-year universities in Louisiana
 - * English I, II, III, IV
 - * Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and 1 credit from either, Adv. Math I, II, or Calculus
 - * Physical Science, Biology I, Chemistry, and 1 credit from either Biology II, Biology II/Anatomy, Physics or Environmental Science
 - * World Geography, Civics, U.S. History, World History
 - * 2 years of same foreign language
 - * 1 art credit (Art, Theatre, Fine Arts Survey)
 - * $\frac{1}{2}$ credit in Health and $1 \frac{1}{2}$ credits in Physical Education
 - * 3 electives
 - * Religious Studies I, II, III, IV
