TRANSCRIPTS

- What is a transcript?
 - A transcript is a legal document of your academic record. Your transcript will indicate your GPA, the classes you took, and your rank in class.

 Required courses
 - [○] English I, II, III, IV
 - Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry and I credit from either Adv.
 Math I, II, or Calculus
 - Physical Science, Biology I, Chemistry, and I credit from either Biology II, Physics, or Environmental Science
 - ^O World Geography, Civics, U.S. History, and World History
 - ^O Fine Arts Survey or I credit in Art or Theatre
 - 2 years of the same foreign language

**No student will be admitted with less than a 2.0 GPA **Students with a 3.0 Cumulative GPA are guaranteed admissions regardless of their ACT scores.

**Any student not meeting these requirements may be admitted by committee.

 - Test Optional
 - (Average ACT score of admitted students was a 23-28)
 - ACT English (18)
 - ACT Math (19)

**Students applying to LSU must use the Common Application and will need recommendations.

(High School Diploma) ACT Score will be used for course placement. Accuplacer is also available.

- Enter as a Transfer Student-Begin your degree at SLCC then transfer to a 4-year institution.
- Earn an Associates Degree (2 year)

- Students applying to selective colleges and or applying for scholarships will need letters of recommendations from their counselors and teachers.
- A Student Resumé helps recommenders get a bigger picture of your accomplishments, interests, and future plans. Students will build their resume in Scoir.



VISITING COLLEGES

- It is a good idea to visit each college that you are considering. Tour the campus, attend an activity, but most importantly, talk with students.
- The admissions office at most universities can arrange a visit for you. Remember, you are not only choosing a place to go to school, but a home for the next four years.
- Several colleges host "Senior Day" on their campus. Visit their websites to learn more about these activities
- Let the front office and teachers know ahead of time when you will be out on a college visit.
- You are responsible for making up any missed work and/or test.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Why complete the FAFSA?

- $^{\circ}$ Grants (free money based on need)
- Loan (low interest loan-government)
- TOPS (Federal government forwards your application to Louisiana Government (LOSFA) Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance processes for any aid they offer. This is when TOPS kicks in if students have met CORE GPA and ACT requirements.
- You will complete the FAFSA during the Fall of your senior year.
 The application will open for the Class of 2026 on a designated date.

- When registering for the ACT, select colleges that you are applying to.
- Login into your ACT account and select "Send Scores" (fees apply)
- Send your scores to LOSFA/TOPS
 Office code: 1595



SCHOLARSHIPS

- Colleges and Universities (example)
 - UL-Lafayette: 3.0 cum gpa, 23 ACT; no application; apply for admission; must have earned the ACT 23 and the 3.0 gpa by May 31
 - LSU: no application; apply for admission by Dec. 15th. To be be considered for a scholarship. LSU will consider ACT scores up until May 31.
 - Other colleges: Each college is different. Inquire or research their scholarship section.
- Scholarship opportunities will be linked in your Scoir Drive. Students are encouraged to check Scoir and emails daily.
- Several Scholarships opportunities will also be available in the Senior College Handbook scholarship page. College Counseling Resources can be found on the TCHS Website. Listed under Academics/Guidance.
