Application Process

The application process for the 2023-2024 school year takes place during the month of January; it begins **Thursday, January 12, 2023** and the <u>deadline</u> to apply is **Tuesday, January 31, 2023**. There is no application fee.

Siblings of students currently enrolled at TCHS must follow these same procedures and comply with the deadlines. All sections of the online application must be completed and all supplemental documentation must be uploaded. Failure to do so will result in the student's application being placed on hold, thereby delaying the admissions process, and the student will be placed in line with others in the wait pool.

All applicants will be notified about the status of the application via email in **mid-to-late February**. Due to the volume of applications, all deadlines will be strictly enforced. Applications are not timestamped.

Registration and scheduling information will be provided following acceptance to TCHS.

Required Supplemental Documentation for Admissions

Applicants will be required to upload and save the following documents in <u>PDF format</u>. Please make sure to **name** documents using the following format: **Applicant Name.document name** (for example, "John Doe.Social Security Card" or "Jane Smith.Standardized Test Scores"):

- Report card from current grade (if applying after the 3rd quarter, submit mid-term report card)
- Most recent standardized test scores
- Educational evaluation or medical assessment (if applicable)
- Pastoral Report (for Catholic out-of-parish applicants only)
- Discipline /Behavior Records official school behavior report that includes a **complete two-year timeframe**. (Applicants attending the following schools **need not** provide a Discipline Report: Carencro Catholic, Holy Family, St. Bernard, St. Genevieve, St. Ignatius, Sts. Leo-Seton, and Sts. Peter and Paul)

In addition to the documents listed above:

• 9th grade applicants should upload the final report card from the 7th grade

• 10th, 11th and 12th grade applicants should upload a complete transcript from their previous/current school

Admissions Priority Point System

The amount of points earned by each applicant is held in confidence by the TCHS Administration and Admissions Office. TCHS welcomes students of any race, color or national and ethnic origin. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, gender, national or ethnic origin in its educational policies, financial aid programs, or other school-administered programs. The number of openings is typically fewer than the number of qualified applicants.

Legacy

- Applicant will earn points for each grandparent/great-grandparent (maternal or paternal) who is a graduate of TCHS.
- Applicant will earn bonus points if he/she would be a direct third or fourth generation TCHS student to enroll.

Alumni

• Applicant will earn points if one parent is a graduate of TCHS, additional points if both parents are TCHS graduates.

Siblings Attending TCHS

• Applicant will earn points for each TCHS sibling.

Parishioner of Owner Church Parish (determined by Pastor): Owner parishes include Our Lady of the Assumption Church, St. Bernard Church, St. Charles Borromeo, St. Elizabeth Seton Church, St. Genevieve Church, St. Leo the Great Church, St. Patrick Church, St. Peter Church and Sts. Peter and Paul Church.

Student Discipline
