

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TCHS 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR



Enrollment Process

The application process for the 2022-2023 school year takes place during the month of January; it begins Monday, January 10, and the deadline to apply is Monday, January 31, 2021.

Siblings of students currently enrolled at TCHS must follow these same procedures and comply with the deadlines. All sections of the on-line application must be completed and all supplemental documentation must be uploaded. Failure to do so will result in the student's application being placed on hold, thereby delaying the admissions process, and the student will be placed in line with others in the wait pool. All applicants will be notified about the status of the application via email in mid to late February. There is no application fee; registration fees are due during the registration process, following acceptance to TCHS. See below for registration procedures.

Due to the volume of applications, all deadlines will be strictly enforced. Applications are not time-stamped.

Admissions Priority Point System

The amount of points earned by each applicant is held in confidence by the TCHS Administration and Admissions Office. TCHS welcomes students of any race, color or national and ethnic origin. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, gender, national or ethnic origin in its educational policies, financial aid programs, or other school-administered programs. The number of openings is typically fewer than the number of qualified applicants.

Legacy

- Applicant will earn points for each grandparent/great-grandparent (maternal or paternal) who is a graduate of TCHS.
- Applicants will earn bonus points if he/she would be a direct third or fourth generation TCHS student to enroll.

Alumni

- Applicants will earn points if one parent is a graduate of TCHS, additional points if both parents are TCHS graduates.

Sibling Attending TCHS

- Applicants will earn points for each TCHS sibling.

Grade Point Average

- Final GPA for previous school year
- Semester GPA for current school year

Complete Battery Percentile

- Points on most recent national standardized tests

Student Involvement

- Extra-curricular and co-curricular activities for church, school, and civic community.

Student Discipline (Determined by Principal)

- Principal from the applicant's current/previous school will utilize a Likert scale to determine the level of the applicant's behavior.
- Principal from the applicant's current/previous school must report if the applicant has multiple suspensions or has been recommended for expulsion.

Registration

You will be notified by email of the status of your child’s application on or before February 25, 2022. Registration for the 2022-2023 school year will take place March 7-11, 2022. It is mandatory all accepted students register within the specified dates and pay the registration fee to assure their enrollment status and avoid the late penalty. More detailed enrollment and registration information will be sent to qualified applicants after acceptance to Teurlings Catholic High School.

Explanation of Fees

- Tuition:** Parents of Catholic students must be registered, active, and contributing for the period of one year in one of the official owner parishes of TCHS in order to qualify for the in-parish tuition rate.
- Registration:** Non-refundable and due and payable at the time of registration. To participate in try-outs for the upcoming school term, applicants must be registered.
- Growth Fee:** An annual payment per student for the perpetual maintenance and growth of the Teurlings Catholic physical plant.
- Senior Fee:** Required fee for students registering for twelfth grade.
- Student Fee:** Funds student admission to athletic events and theatrical productions, and student resource officer.
- Technology Fee:** Funds multi-year Chromebook usage and maintenance, student technology services.
- Raffle Ticket:** Admits two adults to this fund-raising activity, sponsored by TCHS and the Teurlings All Sports Club.
- Debts:** Delinquent accounts may prohibit your child from attending TCHS the second semester. All financial obligations must be met before diplomas, transcripts, and/or school records can be released to schools, colleges, and employers.

Additional, optional charges depend on the degree to which the student is involved in extracurricular activities.

Payment Options

The registration fee is required at the time of registration, March 7-11, 2022. During completion of the online enrollment packet, all families will be required to sign up for the FACTS Payment Plan, regardless of your plans to pay in full or finance tuition. After registration:

1. Reduce your monthly note by making payments toward the principal on or before June 15, 2022. These payments must be mailed in to school or dropped off and cannot be paid online.
2. A finance charge of 10% will apply to any balance not paid by June 15, 2022. Ten equal payments on your choice of the 5th or 20th of the month, beginning July 2022 and ending April 2023, will be automatically drafted from a designated checking account, savings account, credit card, or debit card; these payments will include both principal and interest.

Refund Policy

Fees for registration, growth, student, yearbook, and class are non-refundable. Tuition is refunded on a quarterly basis.

Delinquency Policy

A late fee of \$25 will be assessed once the account is 10 days past due; students with accounts 60 days or more past due will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities; students with accounts 90 days past due will result in dismissal from Teurlings Catholic. All accounts must be current in order for a student to take midterm or final examinations.

Work-Study Program Information

Teurlings Catholic offers financial assistance through the Work/Study program. This program provides limited assistance to those families meeting the criteria established by the TCHS Advisory/Financial Assistance Committee. Applications are processed and managed through FACTS Management Company. **The link to apply for financial assistance will be made available during the online enrollment process, which begins March 7, 2022.**

Note: There is a \$35.00 non-refundable fee for this application process. Questions regarding the application are to be directed to FACTS Management Company. The deadline to apply with appropriate supporting documentation is Monday, April 4, 2022. Families are notified in writing mid-May regarding the status of their application.

TCHS Individual Student Needs Program

Within the beliefs statement of Teurlings Catholic High School, it is written, “Teurlings Catholic will assist students in discovering and developing their talents by providing a variety of instructional approaches that support their learning and a multitude of assessment opportunities that demonstrate their achievement and mastery of skills and information.”

Ideally, Teurlings Catholic High School would admit every child who seeks a Catholic education. Realistically, we cannot be all things to all people. Teurlings Catholic is a college preparatory high school. We are able to make *accommodations* (the information or amount of information taught is not changed). On the other hand, we cannot make *modifications* (the work format or amount of work required of a student is changed or reduced).

By the time most students reach the high school level of their education and are applying to attend Teurlings Catholic, they have already been evaluated by an educational diagnostician, psychologist, speech/language pathologist, reading specialist, or other educators in the field of learning. Applications are examined before a student is accepted for enrollment. Special needs must be declared on the enrollment application for assessment. There are instances when TCHS cannot accommodate the educational needs of a child.

The Individual Student Needs Program at Teurlings Catholic High School is of limited scope based on a college preparatory schedule of classes and not a special education curriculum. Students must have a recent (no older than three years) professional assessment on file at TCHS in order to qualify for the program.

We are able to offer several individualized intervention techniques such as:

- Time extensions for tests
- Small group testing environment
- Enlargement of fonts on reading materials, tests, study guides, etc.
- Preferential seating in the classroom
