*Seniors should make sure that the Art Requirement (1 credit) and the Foreign Language requirement (2 credits from same language) have been fulfilled before scheduling any of the electives below.

Any student considering Pathway 3 of the Math Curriculum (both Geometry and Algebra II in 10th grade) should contact a Guidance Counselor before deciding whether to begin with Art or Foreign

Language in the 9th grade year.
