



TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE

2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

REGISTRATION FEE

One registration fee (\$500) is required per family. This non-refundable fee is due at the time of submission of the enrollment/re-enrollment packet in March. A \$100 late registration fee will be assessed to families who fail to meet the established deadline.

TUITION

The following criteria is used to determine tuition rates: (1) registered parishioner at a TCHS Owner Catholic Parish; (2) registered parishioner at a non-owner Catholic Church; or (3) the family is non-Catholic.

FEES	EXPLANATION OF FEES
MAINTENANCE FEE \$300	An annual payment dedicated to the perpetual maintenance and growth of the Teurlings Catholic High School physical plant.
STUDENT FEE \$200	Funds student admission to athletic events, theatrical productions, and the Student Resource Officer. This also offsets the cost of the TCHS Yearbook.
TECHNOLOGY FEE \$200	Funds multi-year Chromebook usage, maintenance and student technology services.

OTHER FEES (IF APPLICABLE)	EXPLANATION OF FEES
SENIOR FEE - CLASS OF 2027 \$230	Required for students registering for the 12 th grade. This fee helps defray the expenses associated with senior activities including graduation, senior class photo, senior crawfish boil and passion play.
ATHLETIC FEE \$200	This fee will be assessed by the individual sport and will be billed at the beginning of each season as an "incidental expense." This fee covers costs associated with field maintenance, equipment, LHSAA fees, etc.
Tuition Raffle (Optional) \$100	Winner will receive a \$5,000 tuition credit for the 2026-2027 school year at TCHS. The winner will be drawn during Back to School Night (date TBA). Winner need not be present to win.
