## **TCH Memorial Award** (established 1980's)



# Stadium Dedication

## TEURLINGS CATHOLIC BLESSES AND DEDICATES NEW STADIUM THIS MORNING

Lafayette, LA – Bishop Michael Jarrell, Teurlings Catholic Chancellor Hampton Davis, and Principal Michael Boyer welcomed faculty, staff, the entire student body, visiting clergy, alumni, parents, representatives of the Diocese of Lafayette and community leaders to the first event to ever be held at the new Rebel Stadium. The Blessing and Dedication Ceremony marked the official opening of a project that has been decades in the making.

“Congratulations to the Teurlings family. They have worked hard and should be very proud of this historic day,” said Bishop Michael Jarrell.






