Dear Parents,

Over the past weeks, we have had students at TCHS test positive for COVID-19 or who were quarantined because of exposure to the virus. We follow the guidelines of the Louisiana Department of Health Emergency Order (School reporting and Data Sharing Order) and the Diocese of Lafayette as it relates to the reporting of and protocol of exposure of virus positivity.

With all students on campus, many classrooms are compromised by size and cannot meet the six (6) feet social distancing standard of care. In the case of a student testing positive, we are required by State Law to conduct contact tracing of the positive student for the 48 hours before he/she tested positive. Any student seated less than six feet to the right, left, and in front of the positive student must be quarantined for 14 days from the time of exposure. We currently have 33 students quarantined from said exposure.

We must limit the number of students in each class and create the required social distance to alleviate the need to quarantine students because of exposure.

Beginning tomorrow, Thursday, October 1, TCHS will return to the A/B Hybrid class format, beginning with Group A, until further notice. Those students who were granted permission to change groups based on transportation needs will again be assigned to their requested group.
