





 REGISTRATION - Each team must register or check-in at Cypress Cove Landing on the levee starting at 4:30 a.m., June 1, 2024. Boat numbers will be assigned to each team along with a chip that must be turned in prior to weigh-in. Ditty bags will be distributed upon registration.


