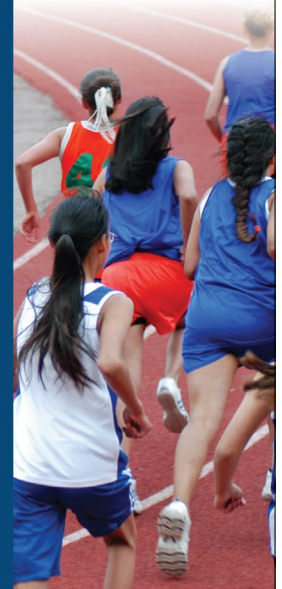

- REGISTRATION** - Each team must register or check-in at Cypress Cove Landing on the levee starting at 6:30 a.m., June 1, 2024. Boat numbers will be assigned to each team along with a chip that must be turned in prior to weigh-in. Dirty bags will be distributed upon registration.
- FISHING HOURS & BOUNDARIES** - Check-in will start at 4:30 a.m., June 1, 2024. All participants must sign in and launch at Cypress Cove Landing on the levee before tournament begins. Boat can depart the launch at safe daylight, but fishing will begin at 6:30 a.m. Boundaries consist of all public waterways accessible from Henderson. **NO PULLOVERS ALLOWED.** The scales will be open at 1:30 p.m. All teams must check in by 3:00 p.m. Scales will close at 3:30.
- SPORTSMANSHIP** - Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are expected from each participant. Any infraction of those fundamental sporting principals or violation of any local, state or federal laws may be deemed cause for disqualification. Any act of a competitor (verbal or physical), that reflects unfavorably upon this tournament's effort to promote fishing, conservation, clean waters, courtesy and safety shall be reason for disqualification from this and all future tournaments.
- ELIGIBILITY** - A team must consist of two anglers, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. No one is allowed in the boat that is not registered for the tournament. An adult choosing a minor as a partner will take full responsibility for that minor. Valid fishing license for each angler is required. Boat numbers will be assigned at the time of registration of tournament. Boat operator must be 18 years or older and must comply with all state and federal regulations. All boats must have aerated live well keeping fish alive. **Must have water cooled outboard.**
- SAFETY** - Safe boat conduct must be observed at all times. Drunkenness on the part of any contestant will not be tolerated. All boats must be equipped with some type of emergency kill switch. ALL BOATS MUST HAVE US COAST GUARD EQUIPMENT AS REQUIRED BY LAW. USCC APPROVED LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN AND KILLSWITCH ATTACHED. ANYTIME MOTOR IS RUNNING, ALL BOATS MUST BE CHECKED AND TAGGED BEFORE LAUNCHING.
- TACKLE** - Any angler may only use one rod at a time. Other rods can be in the boat for substitute purposes only. This is a CATCH AND RELEASE tournament. All live fish must be released by tournament officials. Only artificial lures can be used no prepared or live bait other than pork rind strips. Only rod and reel outfits may be used, no trolling is permitted.
- SCORING** - 5 fish limit - Minimum 12" in length. Scoring will be used on the weights in pounds of bass. Each dead fish weighed in is a 0.25 pound (.4 oz) penalty. Culling of dead fish is PROHIBITED. Teams are not allowed to have more than 5 fish in their permanent possession at any time, except for culling the 6th fish. If more than 5 fish are kept in a team's possession, that team shall be disqualified for the day and shall receive no weight for the day. It is the responsibility of the team to keep fish alive. Any angler suspected of cheating is subject to a polygraph test upon tournament placement.
- PROTEST** - Complaints or protests must be submitted to the tournament committee by close of weigh in. All decisions rendered to the committee are final.

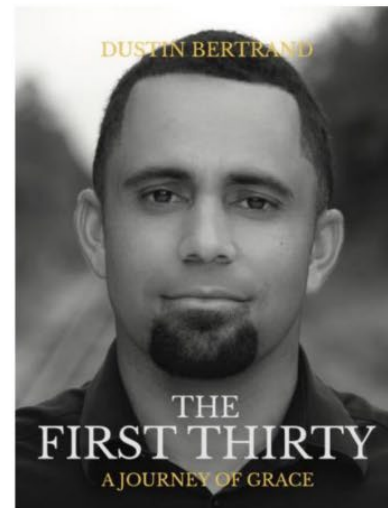
