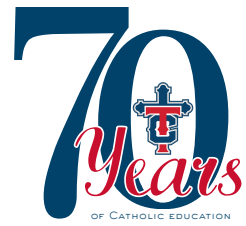

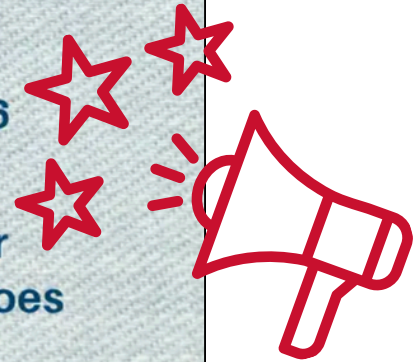

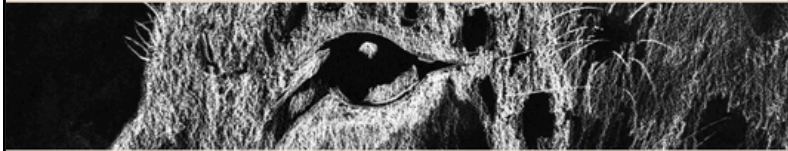

**DANCE POLICIES:** All school rules apply at all school functions. Breathalyzers will be administered to everyone entering the dance. No one will be admitted into the dance after 7:30pm and no one will be allowed to leave the dance until 9:30pm. Guests may not leave early.

All Junior and Senior TCHS students will make sure to do the following:

- Fill out the google form sent to your TCHS email from Mrs. Farris. If you are bringing a non-TCHS date, you must also upload the signed guest form and a pictured school or state ID of your guest to the google form. Get those photos before you fill out the google form.
- Purchase tickets through Go Fan for entry into the dance. The cost of tickets for TCHS students is \$20 and for non-TCHS dates is \$25.

\*\*No one will be allowed to enter the dance who has not filled out the google form and purchased tickets on Go Fan by April 13, 2026.

### **TCHS DANCE ATTIRE GUIDELINES (Taken from the TCHS Student Parent Handbook)**

Teurlings Catholic High School dances are an event, which reflects the philosophy of our school and the teachings of the Catholic Church. Among our most important considerations is adherence to Church teachings regarding modesty.

According to The Catechism of the Catholic Church, "Purity requires modesty. Modesty protects the intimate center of the person. It means refusing to unveil what should remain hidden. It is ordered to chastity to whose sensitivity it bears witness . . . Modesty is decency. It inspires one's choice of clothing. It keeps silence or reserve where there is evident risk of unhealthy curiosity. It is discrete . . . Teaching modesty to children and adolescents means awakening in them respect for the human person."

In accordance with these directives of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, Teurlings Catholic High School sets forth the following dress guidelines for our students and their dates:

#### **GIRLS:**

##### 1. TOPS

- The neckline of a dress, top, or gown must be cut in a modest way. If cleavage is showing, the student will be asked to leave the dance. Spaghetti straps or strapless dresses are allowed, as long as they are not low cut.
- The cut of a dress in the back and sides must not be below the natural bra line. Backless dresses are not allowed.

##### 2. LENGTH

- A dress, skirt, or gown, must be below the knee. (*in a standing position*)
- Any see-through fabric (*mesh, lace, etc.*) on the skirt of the dress **MUST** be below the knee as well; nothing see-through allowed above the knee.
- Slits in a dress/skirt must be below the knee.
- Overall, **EVERYTHING** is below the knee.

##### 3. MISCELLANEOUS

- No midriff is allowed to show.
- No navel is allowed to show.
- The bodice of the dress must not have any fabric cutouts (this includes openings covered with net-like fabric, lace, mesh, etc.).
- Dresses should not be excessively tight.

#### **BOYS:**

- Tuxedo or suits are required. *Sport coats and slacks are not permitted.*

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:** Admittance to the dance, with consideration of attire, will be left to the discretion of the faculty and administration who are present that evening. If a student is in doubt as to the expected modesty of his or her chosen attire, he or she should consult with administration before the dance to avoid the embarrassment of being turned away.

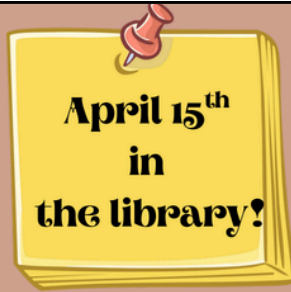

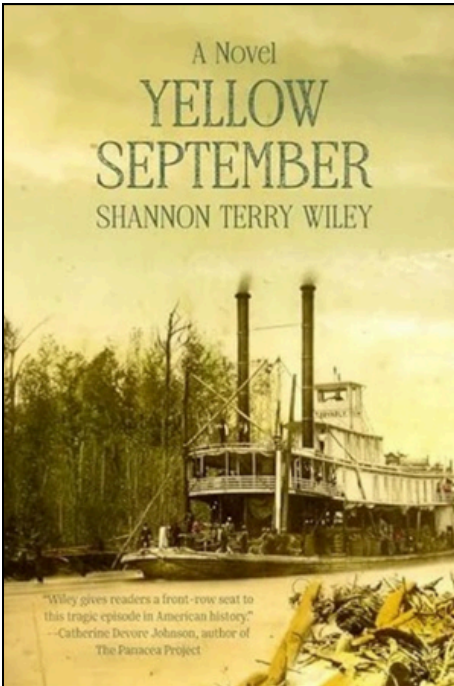
