

## REBEL AMBASSADORS

### Who is chosen to be a member of the Rebel Ambassadors?

Rebel Ambassadors are a select group of Teurlings Catholic students who are invited to join an elite organization. Students are chosen based on applications received by the Development Director and teacher recommendations. A diverse group of students representing a wide range of elementary schools should be chosen. Students chosen should be willing to lead small groups, and must be energetic, enthusiastic, and friendly. ***Because this organization requires students to miss class, only students who are academically eligible to leave class will be selected.***

**SOCIAL MEDIA:** Making a commitment to Rebel Ambassadors requires making a commitment to your school in all aspects, including social media posts. By signing to fully commit to being a Rebel Ambassador you agree to comply with the school's acceptable use of technology policy, which can be found in the Teurlings Catholic High School Student/Parent Handbook. Any posts by a Rebel Ambassador which bring defamation to Teurlings Catholic High School or any of its students or employees will not be tolerated; the Rebel Ambassador will be immediately dismissed from the club and the situation will be handled through the school's discipline system.

### Purpose:

The purpose of the Rebel Ambassadors is to be "good will ambassadors" for TCH. This means each member of the organization is dedicated to welcoming anyone and everyone visiting TCH and considering attending Teurlings, as well as continuing to be hospitable to those who are currently enrolled at TCH.

### Costs:

The cost to participate as a Rebel Ambassador is a **new member fee of \$18**. Checks may be made payable to TCH and are **due after Rebel Ambassadors are chosen**.

### Rebel Ambassadors shall:

- Help host TCH Day (mandatory) and Open House night (optional); both Tuesday, October 16, 2018
- Direct parents to classrooms for Back to School Night
- Assist with Grandparents' Liturgy
- Be available for student shadows, entertaining potential new students
- Execute various other functions welcoming everyone to our campus
- Respect themselves and their school on and off campus.
