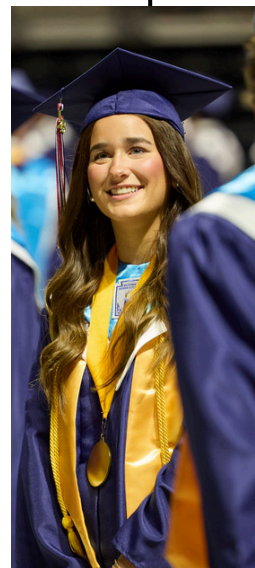


COMMITMENT TO ACADEMICS

This past school year we have been able to offer so many unique opportunities to our students! The Holy Spirit is moving on our campus and it has been truly beautiful to witness. Last spring, we were able to send 13 students on a Kairos retreat at another school in hopes of starting Kairos here at Teurlings. In March, we hosted our first Kairos Retreat, with 50 juniors and seniors in attendance, who were led by their peers who had a vision for how this retreat could impact their classmates. That vision has continued to grow, and in September, we hosted our second Kairos Retreat, with 55 students in attendance, led by 19 of our senior campus ministers. 2 Corinthians tells us "where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom." We are certainly watching the work of the Spirit move in the lives of our students and set them free from their burdens. The Lord is good, and is touching the heart of Teurlings.
