



Did you know?

The Dual Enrollment Program, run in conjunction with Louisiana Tech University, Northwestern State University and the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, allows students to earn college credit while taking courses at Teurlings Catholic. Dual Enrollment courses are considered to be honors courses at TCHS and count as such in determining honor graduate status. DE courses taught by on campus instructors are offered in English III, English IV, American History, World History, French II, Biology II (for non-majors), College Algebra, and College Trigonometry. Online courses are offered during regular class hours in Communications, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, Fine Arts Survey, Food and Nutrition, Geography, Psychology, Sociology, and Spanish III.

Eva had an eighth grade education because many African Americans were not able to attend high school, and Collins had only a first grade education because when his father died, he had to quit school to help his mother care for his younger siblings and work in the fields. Both Eva and Collins had strong faith in which they consistently and

successfully instilled in their children. They were the first couple to marry in Notre Dame Catholic Church in 1939. Both were active in the church. Eva was a Eucharistic Minister for over 20 years, Altar Lady, and a member of the Block Rosary Group and Charismatic Choir. Collins was an active member of the Ushers' Society, Legion of Mary, Holy Name of Jesus Society, the Nocturnal Adoration Society, and the Knights of Peter Claver. The James family has always been active in the church and taught their children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren to do the same. TCHS Memorial Award


The TCHS Memorial Award is presented to a graduate who has exhibited ability and determination during his or her high school years at Teurlings Catholic.
